**Mary Lou Soffa** is the Owen T. Cheatham Professor and Chair of the Computer Science Department at the University of Virginia. Her research interests include software engineering, program analysis, optimizing and parallelizing compilers, and software tools for debugging and testing programs. In 1999, she received the Presidential Award for Excellence in Science, Mathematics and Engineering Mentoring. She was elected an ACM Fellow in 1999. She serves on the Board of the Computing Research Association (CRA) and CRA-W, the committee on the status of women in CS&E.

**Lalita Jategaonkar Jagadeesan** is a Distinguished Member of Technical Staff in the Computing Sciences Research Center at Bell Labs Research, Lucent Technologies. She has a PhD in computer science from MIT. She has been the director of the Software Production Research department in Bell Labs Research, and a director in the Software Technology Center in Bell Labs Advanced Technologies. Lalita's research interests include performance and reliability analysis, automated verification and testing, multi-modal systems, concurrency theory, and software engineering, and she has published papers and holds patents in these areas.
