Running the Sketch Tcl/Tk program.

- 1. Download the scripts and images from the assignment page on the Web. Save these files to the hard disk of your PC or Mac or your CIS dept. directory.
- 2. For the four image files, do the following:

Images directory: The program will use the home directory where you launch the program to look for the "images" directory which contains the images used by Sketch.

- 3. To run this program, you will need to use Wish to interpret all of the script files in the following manner:
 - Open all five of the scripts in your favorite text editor (Work, Simpletext, Wordpad, Notepad, pico, emacs, etc.)
 - In the *exact order* listed below, copy and paste the source from the text editor into the Console window provided by the Wish interpreter, hitting return after each paste command. You cannot simply source the code, but must use copy/paste. If you do not copy/paste in the exact order shown, you will get undefined procedure errors.
 - 1. dialog.tcl
 - 2. clrdial.tcl
 - 3. clrmenu.tcl
 - 4. balloon.tcl
 - 5. sketch.tcl
